**ADMINISTRATION OF THE BASIC EDUCATION EXIT ASSESSMENT
FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2018-2019**

To: OIC, Office of the Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisors
Education Program/Public Schools District Supervisors/Division Coordinators
Heads of Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA), shall administer the **Basic Education Exit Assessment (BEEA) for the School Year (SY) 2018-2019 from February 13 to 14, 2019** to all Grade 12 students in public and private schools nationwide. This is pursuant to DepEd Order (DO) No. 55, s. 2016 entitled **Policy Guidelines on the National Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Basic Education Program**, and DO 25, s. 2018 entitled **School Calendar for School Year 2018-2019**.
2. BEEA for Grade 12 aims to:
 - a. determine students' learning progress and their attainment of the learning standards and 21st century skills;
 - b. help provide information to improve instructional practices
 - c. assess the effectiveness and efficiency of education service delivery using learning outcomes as indicators; and
 - d. provide empirical information as basis for the improvement of the curriculum, learning delivery, and assessment and for policy review and formulation.
3. The BEEA for Grade 12 learners shall cover the following core subjects: Science, Philosophy, Humanities, Media Information Literacy, Mathematics, Language and Communication (English and Filipino), and Social Science.
4. Relative to this, an orientation on the Standardized Administration of the BEEA to Secondary School Principals will be conducted on **Monday, February 11, 2019 at 9:00 o'clock in the morning at the Dr. Cecilio Putong National High School Library**.
5. Travelling and other incidental expenses of personnel who are involved in the administration of the test shall be charged to their School MOOE/local funds subject to their availability, following the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
